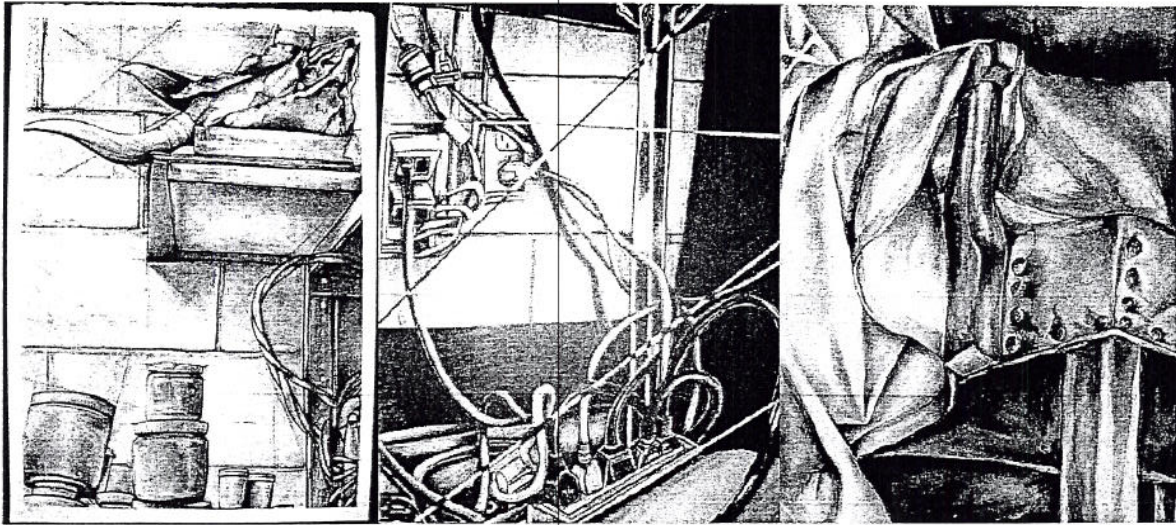


**Objective:**

Students will create one extended linear line drawings. Students should focus on perspective and depth in their compositions. Each student will be expected to complete one drawing in charcoal or pencil.

You should begin by finding an interesting and complex area in the classroom or at home. Build a foundation for your drawing with straight lines that build a framework for your final piece. The final work should allow the lines to breathe.



**CHARCOAL DRAWING**

1. Students should focus on the following in creating their finished piece:
2. Paper under 18X24 (46 x 61 cm)
3. Taped Edges
4. Extended Linear Lines. These lines should be incorporated in a smooth way. Lines should show
5. Strong and accurate contour lines
6. Strong contrast using light
7. Lay in a ground with taped edges
8. Appropriate use on the charcoal or pencil. The following can be used: Charcoal Pencil, Pressed Charcoal, Vine & Willow Charcoal, Kneaded Rubber Erasers, Sanford Magic Rub Eraser, Graphite Pencils
9. Use of the eraser method.
10. Strong Composition.
11. All surface covered
12. Weighted Line
